Sharing: a snack AND a show and tell item

Project materials (optional): two coordinating fat quarters and thread to match.

Remember, this is your weekend; do what you need to do for yourself. Read, relax, sew, sing, hike, or eat chocolate- what ever you need to do to recover from the pressures of the outside world. We'll see you on November 5th.
