



Dear Camper,

We are looking forward to having you spend a week with us at Crestfield! We are preparing counselors and materials so that your week will be the best possible. Here is some important information about camp:

**What to bring:**

- Bible
- Writing materials
- Underwear
- Shirts / T-Shirts
- Shorts
- Socks
- Jeans or other long pants
- Swim suit
- Medication in original pharmacy container with label
- Extra shoes or sneakers
- Sleeping bag
- A sheet for warm nights
- Pillow and Pillowcase
- Towels and wash cloths
- Raingear
- Laundry or plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Bug Spray
- Sweatshirt or jacket
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc)
- A set of clothes and a pair of lace-up shoes that can get especially dirty at the clay pits  
(Check Goodwill)

Be prepared for rainy weather and getting wet in the streams at camp. **Please do not bring radios, iPods, cell phones, CD players, gameboys, drugs, firearms, fireworks, knives, weapons of any kind, personal sports equipment, pets, animals, candy, chewing gum, other "junk food" or tobacco.** If you do bring these items, they will be held for you until the end of camp and parents will be notified. Snacks, crafts materials, and songbooks will be provided for all campers.

Please note that Crestfield cannot be responsible for your personal items. We work to form a caring Christian community each week, but we cannot keep track of the things that you bring to camp. Please make sure that all items that you bring to camp have your name on them and that you collect them at the end of the week.

Campers must be accompanied by a parent or designated guardian. Campers who have a driver's licenses are not permitted to drive themselves to camp. **Registration will begin at 3:00pm on the first day of camp for those campers with the last name beginning with A-L and 3:30pm for those campers with the last name beginning with M-Z. Please do not arrive before the scheduled registration time, as our staff will be busy preparing for an exciting week of camp. We invite our parents to attend the closing worship service at the end of each camper week. This will begin at 6:30 on the last day of each week. Departure will occur approximately one half hour after closing worship begins.**

Your parents should pick you up in the cabin and sign the check-out sheet with your counselor when you are leaving. If someone other than the person bringing you to camp will be taking you home, please let us know at registration.
